

St. Edward the Confessor School Pre-K3 Program

Children entering this program must reach the age of three by September 30

In this program, there is a teacher and, when greater than thirteen students, an assistant in the classroom. This is a self-contained, all-day program that begins the foundation for making learning enjoyable.

On a daily basis, the children learn to make the sign of the cross, participate in prayer exercises, and learn of the awareness of God and His Creation.

In this program the children are introduced to:

- ❖ Fine and Gross Motor Activities

- ❖ Sound concepts
- ❖ Upper and lower case letters

A major goal for this age group is for students to be able to print their first name properly. In the second half of the school year, the students are also introduced to technology by way of smart boards.

The children are taught and learn these concepts and skills through play, programs, toys, small groups, and individual instruction from the teacher and assistant teacher.

The children are offered hot lunch, which is brought to the classroom, where the children eat. They also have a daily afternoon nap. Children entering the PK-3 Program must be fully potty trained.
